

POLICY FOR ELECTIVES AND EXCHANGE PROGRAM

A committee would look after all the affairs of Electives and Exchange program. The committee would consist of the following:

1. One member from Administration / Establishment.
2. One member from students branch.
3. One member each from Basic, Clinical and Dental section.
4. One member each from Final year MBBS and BDS, preferably class representatives.

ELECTIVES

Ayub Medical College will accept applications for electives from national and international students on yearly basis.

General Information

Electives would be offered to full time students in good academic standing for 4 weeks in winter vacations of the college. Ayub Medical College will issue yearly calendar of electives at least 3 months before the start of winter vacations. Students who are accepted for electives will be notified one month before start of electives. At the end of rotation there will be formal assessment and students will have to submit comprehensive report of their work

Number of Seats offered would depend on individual departments' capacity. Before the start of each year, all the concerned departments would be asked how many slots they can accommodate at a time.

If any student of Ayub Medical College wants to do electives in some other institution, he/she would be facilitated by the above committee by providing them with a recommendation letter but the permission from the accepting institution would be the responsibility of the student. Moreover it would be on the risk and cost of the student, the college would not provide any financial assistance.

Rotation and Eligibility

MBBS:

Placements in basic sciences: Medical Students of any year may apply for rotations in following disciplines:

1. Anatomy
2. Physiology
3. Pharmacology
4. Biochemistry



Eligibility for Clinical Rotations: Students who have passed their second professional can apply for the following disciplines in addition to the above:

1. Pathology and Microbiology
2. ENT

3. Ophthalmology
4. Community Medicine
5. Accident and emergency

Students who have passed their third professional can apply for the following in addition to the above:

1. General Medicine
2. Gastroenterology
3. Pulmonology
4. Cardiology
5. Neurology
6. General Surgery
7. Neurosurgery
8. Urology
9. Orthopaedics

BDS:

Students of 1st, 2nd and 3rd year BDS can apply for the following:

1. Basic Dental Sciences

Students who have passed their third professional can apply for the following in addition to the above:

1. Clinical Sciences.

A nominal fee, as decided by the college administration may be charged.

EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The initial stage of the student exchange program will include all institutions (both constituent and affiliated) of Khyber Medical University, Peshawar. This is to exclude any disparity between the academic calendars and course content of the different universities.

The interested students are supposed to apply at the end of the session and their selection shall be on the basis of merit according to the marks obtained in the last professional. In case of new first year, the MDCAT / FSc score shall be taken as standard. Two students shall be selected from each session of MBBS and one from BDS.

The students shall proceed to the institute of their choice on reciprocal basis on their own risk and cost.

At the end of each session, the students shall return to AMC along with their performance record, duly verified, to be examined at their own institution.

All the incoming and outgoing students should follow the rules, regulations and discipline of the institution where they were sent.

The duration of the program shall be for the whole academic year (7 to 8 months).




The student exchange program needs to be mentioned in the college prospectus. Additionally the details should be present on the AMC website.

Notice for the students information should be issued at the end of every academic year, and in case of multiple applicants, merit of last year should be taken into consideration.


Students sent from AMC to other institutes, if reported for ill-discipline or under par academic performance, shall be dealt by the disciplinary committee, AMC.

National Level exchange program: It would be dealt at University level (KMU) according to the MOUs between different universities.


International level Exchange program: it would be dealt according to the prevailing government, PMC and HEC policies
