Aims and objectives.

The main aims of elective courses for MBBS students include studying different topics of their interest outside of the core curriculum, developing confidence in their own skills and abilities, acquiring research, communication, and self-directed learning skills, and considering their own career paths.

For successful implementation of elective program at Ayub teaching hospital, there needs to be clarity of intended educational outcomes before, during and after the placement.

- √ 2 in each subspeciality.
- √ 12 in Gynae & Obstetrics (4 in each of the 3 wards)
- ✓ 16 in G. Medicine (4 in each of the 4 wards)
- √ 12 in G. Surgery (4 in each of the 3 wards)
- √ 8 in Peadiatrics (4 in each of the 2 wards)
- √ 10 for Añesthesia
- ✓ 4 for ICU
- √ 6 for Accident and emergency department

Selection criteria:

First come first serve basis. (Students from within the institute/country or abroad can apply).

Students should apply at least one month prior to commencement of winter vacations.

Eligibility: 3rd 4th & final year MBBS students

Duration: 3 to 6 weeks during summer or winter vacations

Timings: 9:00 am - 1:00 pm

Code of conduct:

Students during elective rotation are expected to;

- ✓ Dress up in a simple, decent and appropriate manner, with an ironed white coat and name/ ID visibly displayed.
- ✓ Abide by the ethical, professional, cultural and legal standards set by the institution, department, and individual unit.
- ✓ Be respectful and professional in behaviour when communicating with patients and his/her attendants and respect their privacy, dignity and confidentiality
- Examine patients with their permission, only under supervision or in the presence of chaperon (nurse, female colleague, HO or PGR)
- ✓ Equipped with their own clinical examination gadgets (stethoscope, BP apparatus, measuring tape etc
- Ensure that their actions do not in any way threaten or endanger the health, safety or security of other students or patients.
- ✓ Refrain from any behaviour which will cause damage to hospital property.
- Refrain from any form of disrespect, abusive language, or harassment of other students, nursing staff, faculty, PGs/HOs or patients within or outside the hospital.
